



ROLE DESCRIPTION

Assistant County Commissioner - Adult Support

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE ROLE?

To support the Deputy County Commissioner (Adult Support) in leading the delivery of Adult Support across the County.

WHAT DO I HAVE TO DO?

Deputise for the DCC Adult Support where appropriate

Work with the County & District Commissioners to review & agree the ongoing strategy for the delivery of Adult Support within the County.

Lead on the recruitment of suitable Leaders & Advisers to the County Adult Support Team and ensure they receive appropriate induction, training, ongoing support and supervision.

Work with the County & District Teams to develop and maintain Adult Support (Training non-Wood Badge, Communications, Development & Adult Recognition and advisers) for Leaders.

Help Leaders to enlist support from specialist advisers (Safeguarding, Health & safety, Faiths & Beliefs, Environment & Community and Additional Support Needs).

Work with County SAS Manager to develop Special Interest Support Units.

ANYTHING ELSE?

Meet with members of the Adult Support Team, under your care, regularly to ensure that they receive the support they need and are effective in their role.

Meet with each member of the Adult Support Team, under your care, to carry out an annual review of their contribution to Scouting and their ongoing performance of the role.
